Our students have always proved themselves in academics with 100% results in Board Examination. **During the session 2023-24**, a total of **332 students** appeared in **Board**

examinations in which the highest percentage of class 10th was 96.6% and in class 12th it was 95%.

If I talk about the session 2024-25, a total of 338 students appeared in Board examination in which the highest percentage of class 10th was 98.8%, and in class 12th it was 97.4%.
